## General notes

  - b. Child = Figure based on the Dept of Education needs analysis EFC Formula, 2013-2014 (Table C3: Income Protection Allowance, see note for amount allowed for each additional family member (this is a 9-month figure converted to 12 months)).

## Notes on graduate student fee schedule

1. RA/TA tuition and fees noted are at the Tier I level. Fees paid by RA/TA students include building fee, services and activities fee, and IMA bond fee but exclude technology fee.
2. International graduate tuition and fees are at the Tier III level. Summer tuition and fees do not include building or technology fees. Quarterly fees only.
3. Living expenses for non-RA/TA graduate students includes mandatory student only health insurance, currently \$283.83 for autumn 2014, \$283.83 for winter, spring, and summer 2015
4. Law, MBA and other programs may use the program's specific tuition figures.
